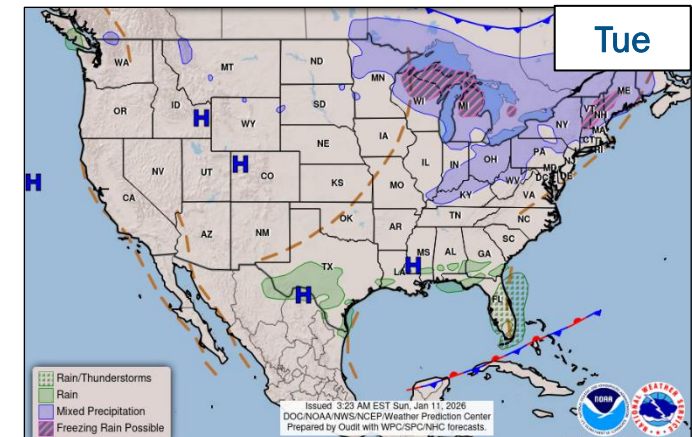
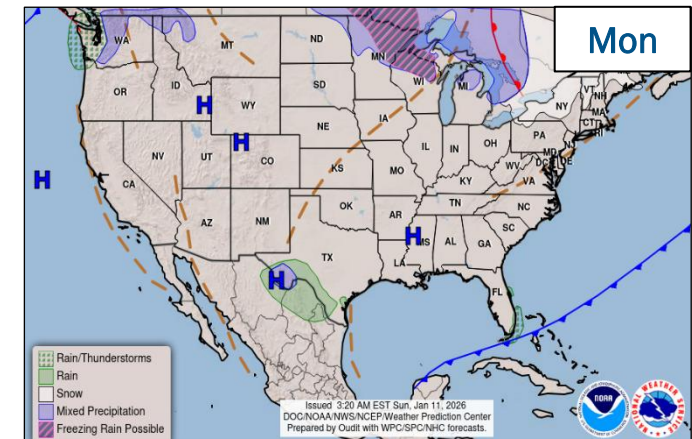
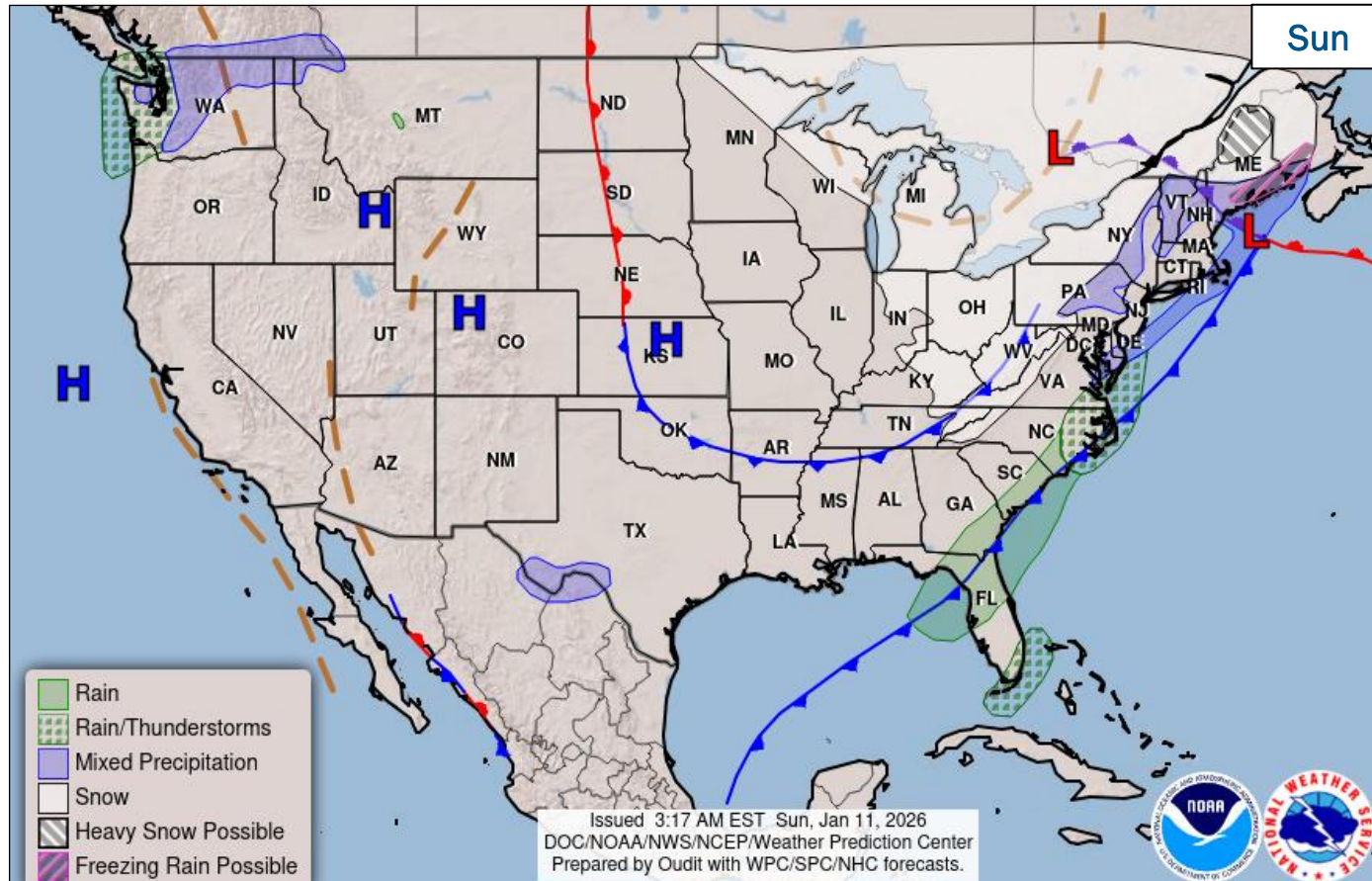

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Snowfall Forecast



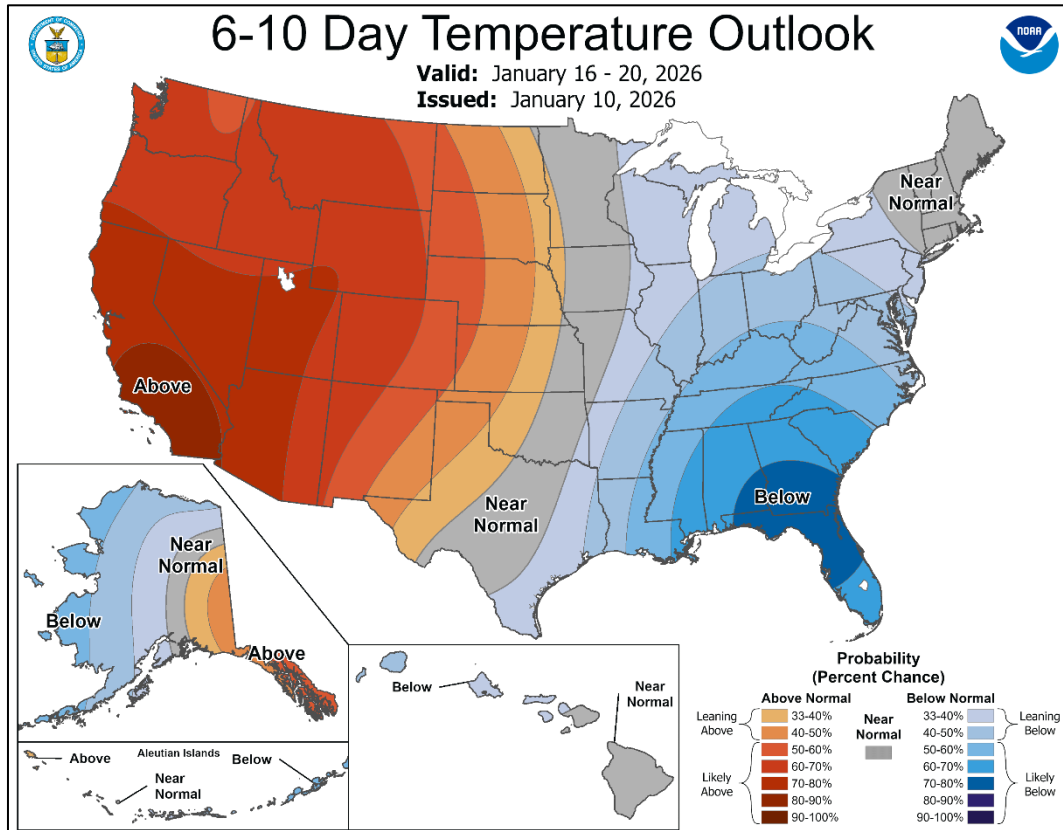
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Ice Accumulation Forecast

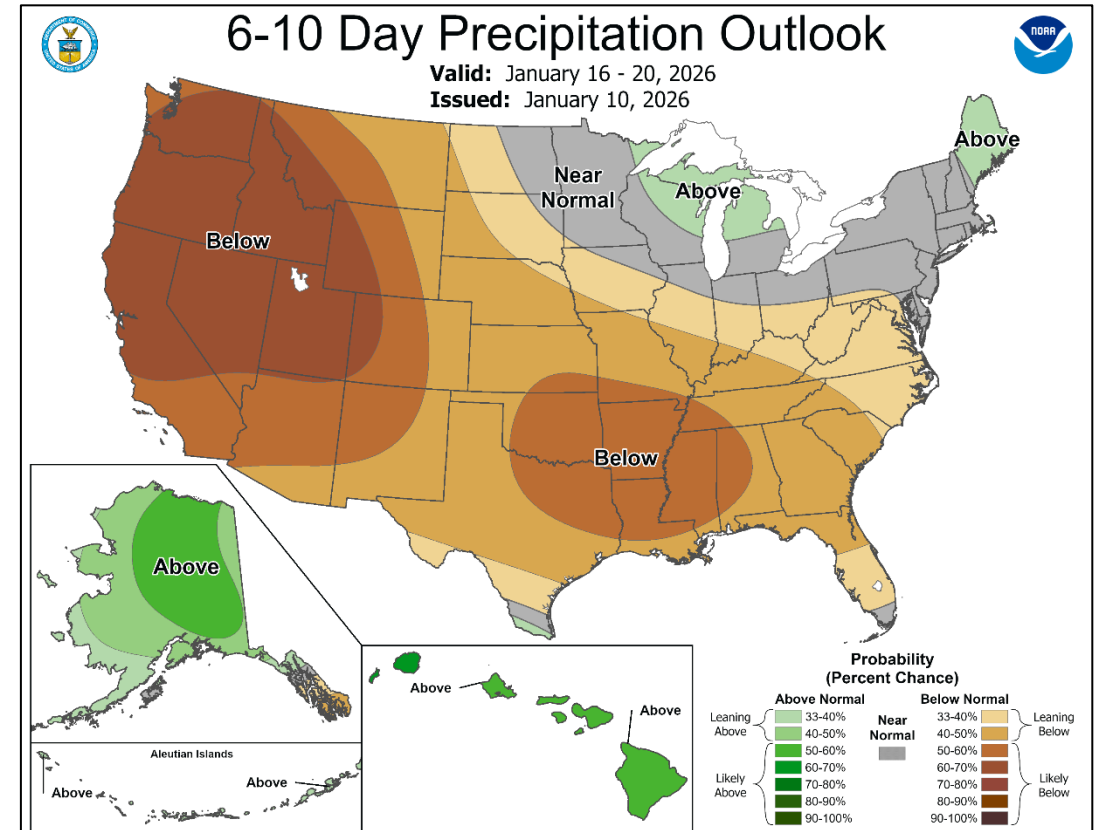


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Long Range Outlooks – Jan 16-20
