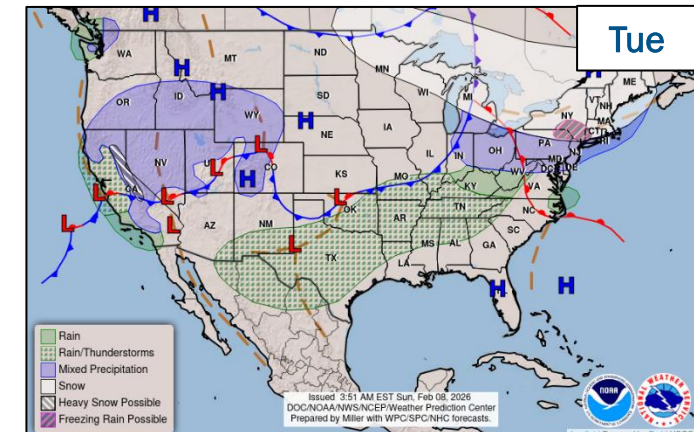
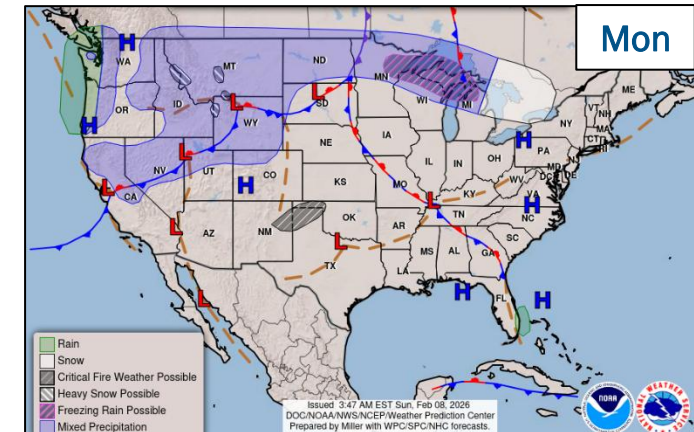
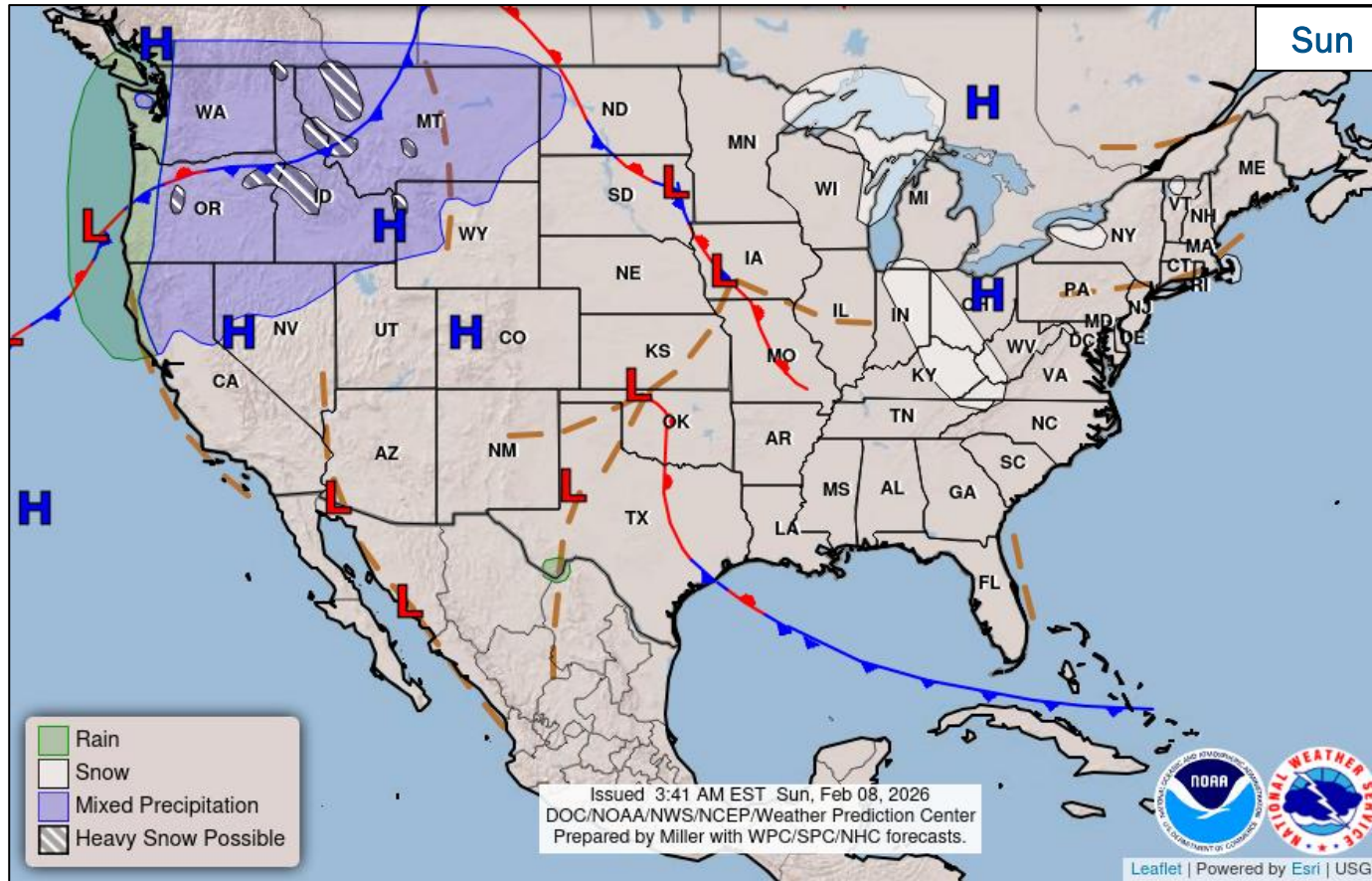

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National Weather Forecast



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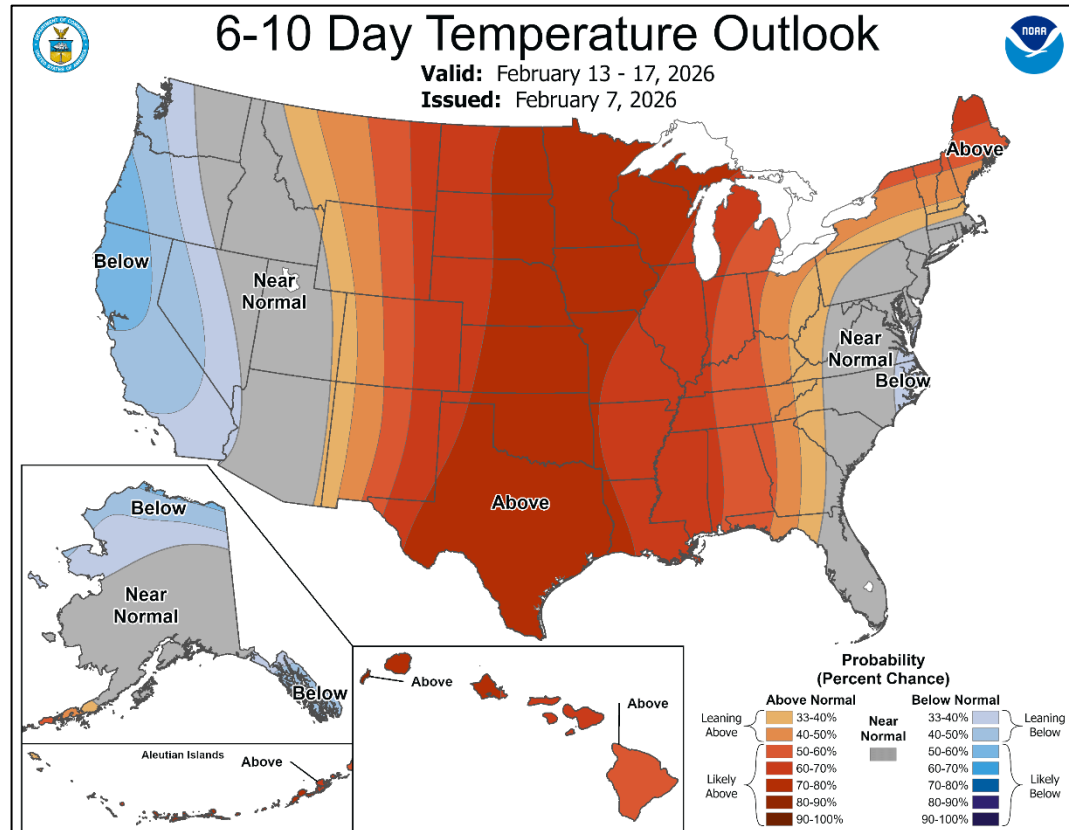
Cold Threatmap



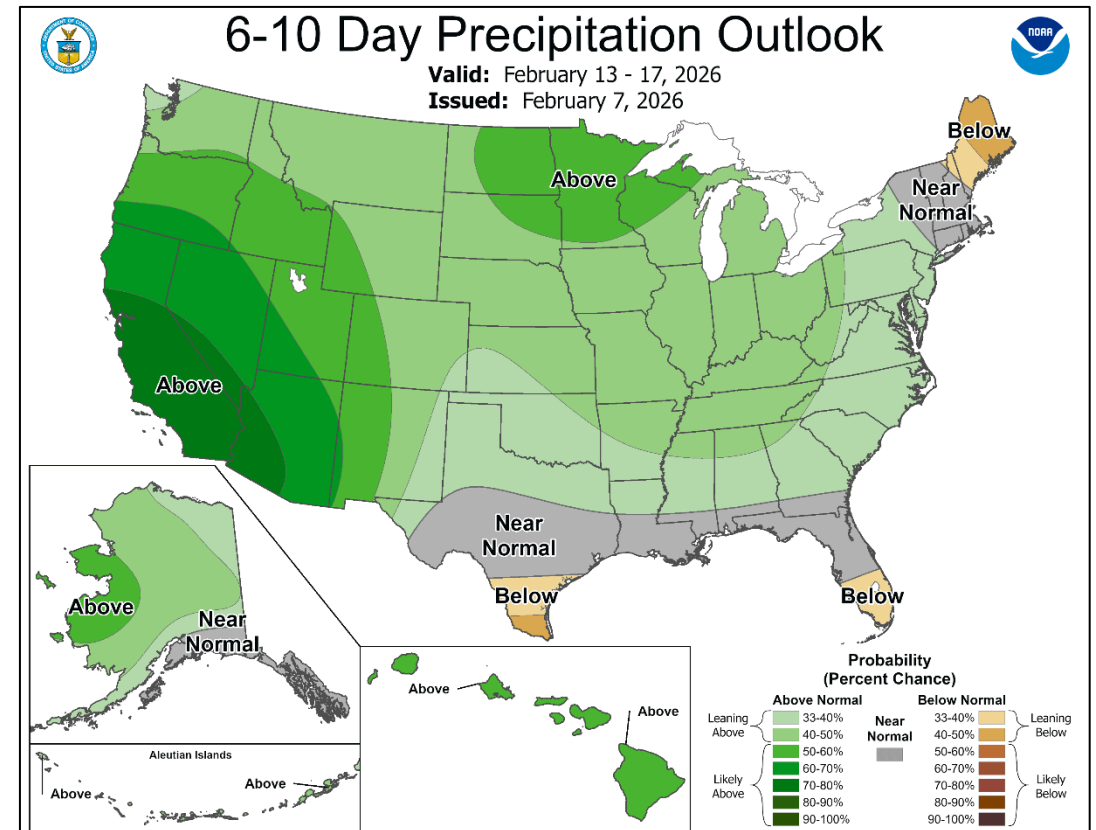
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Long Range Outlooks – Feb 13-17

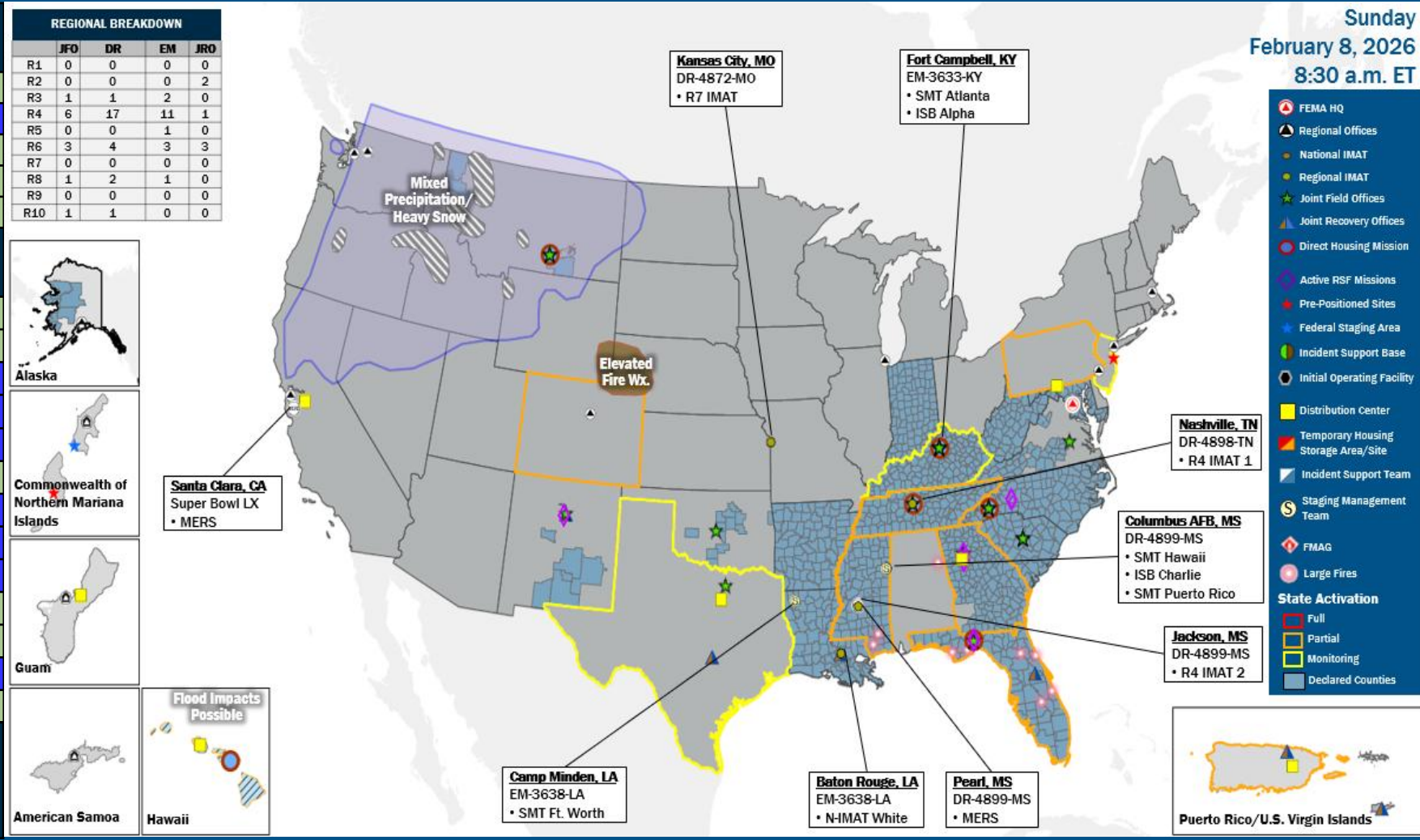
