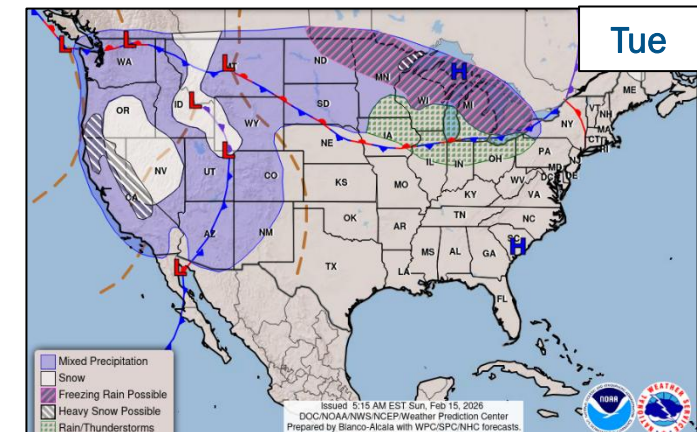

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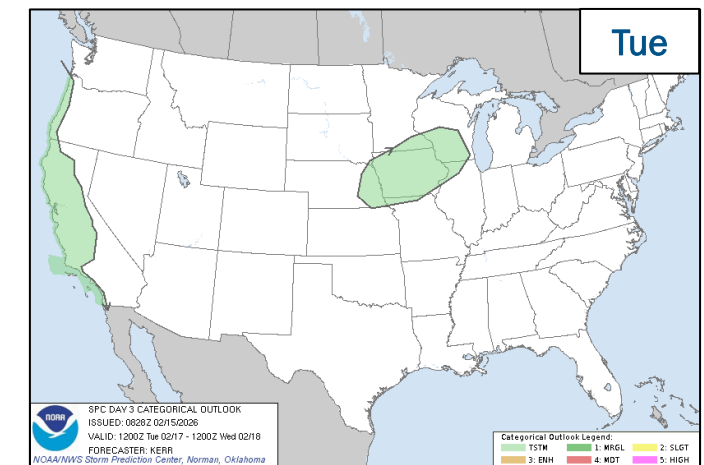
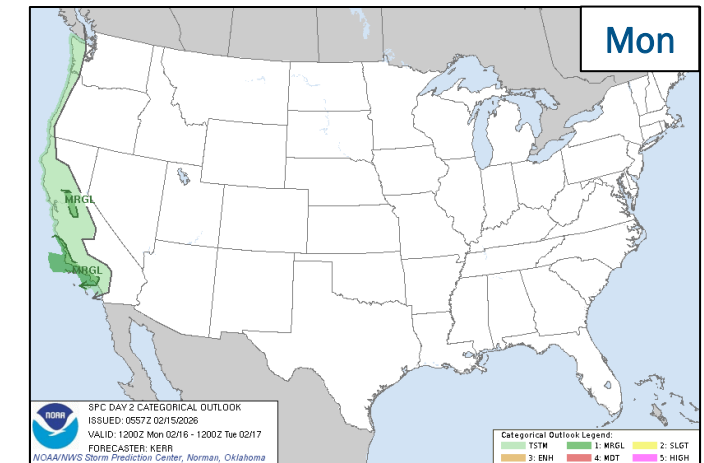
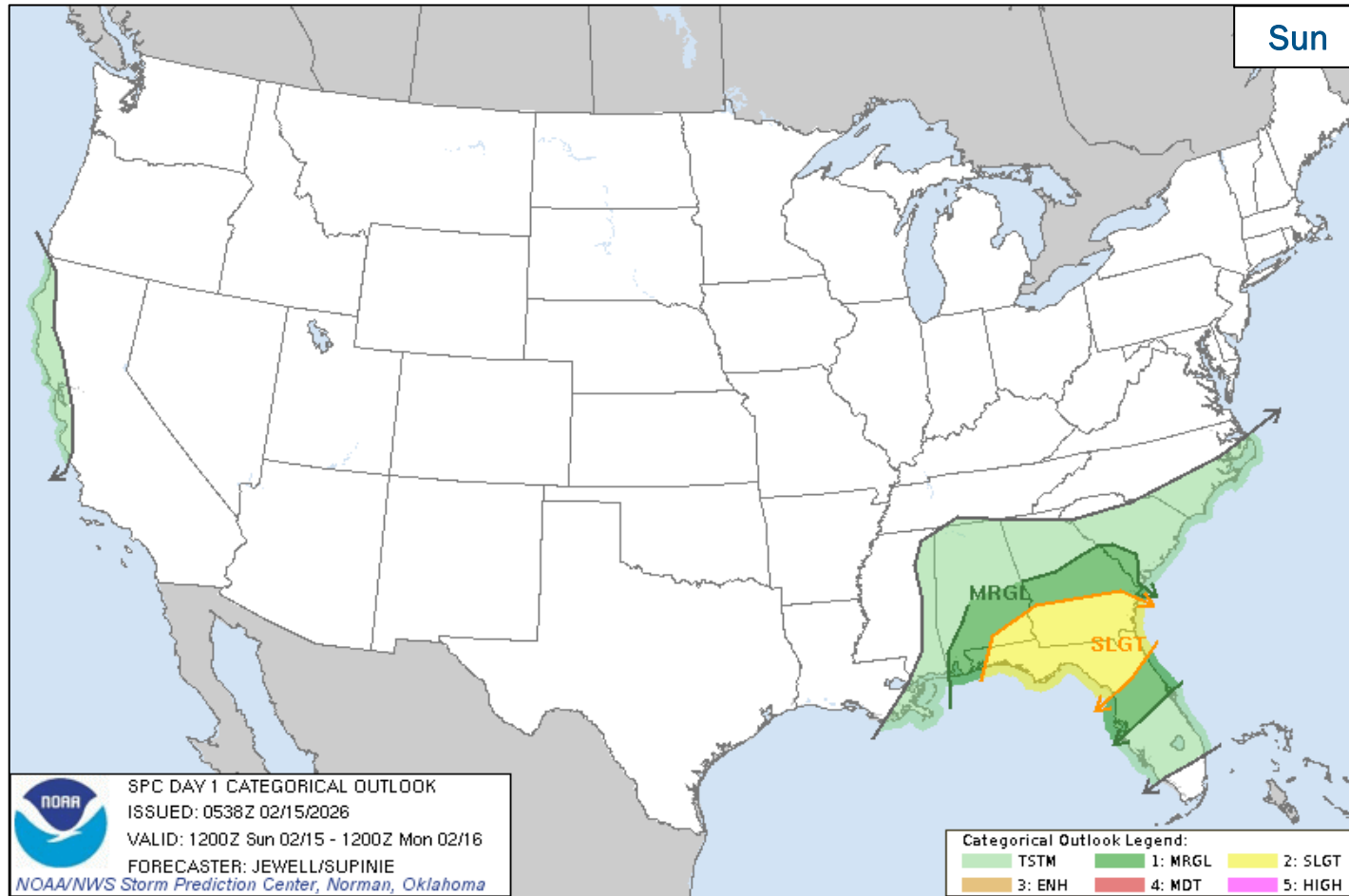
National Weather Forecast



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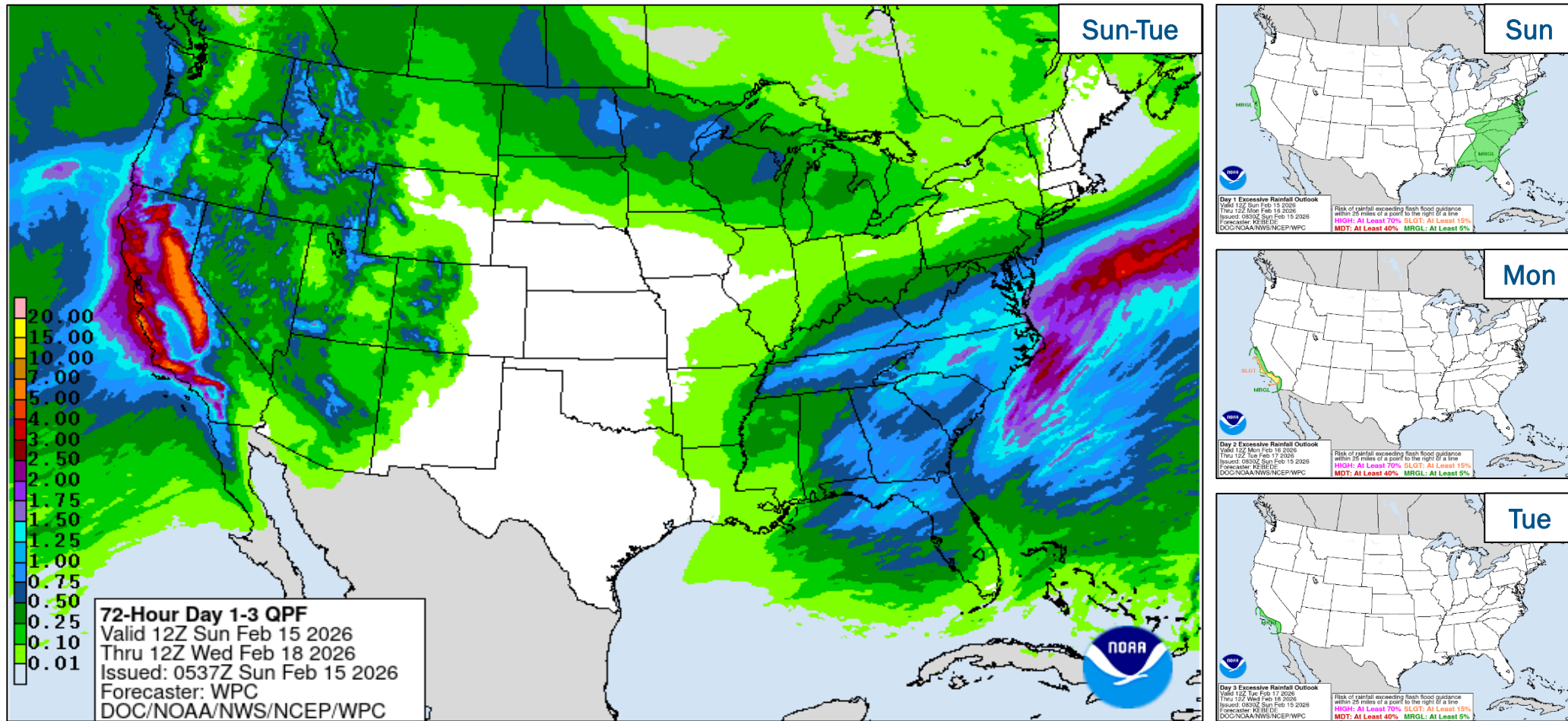
Severe Weather Outlook



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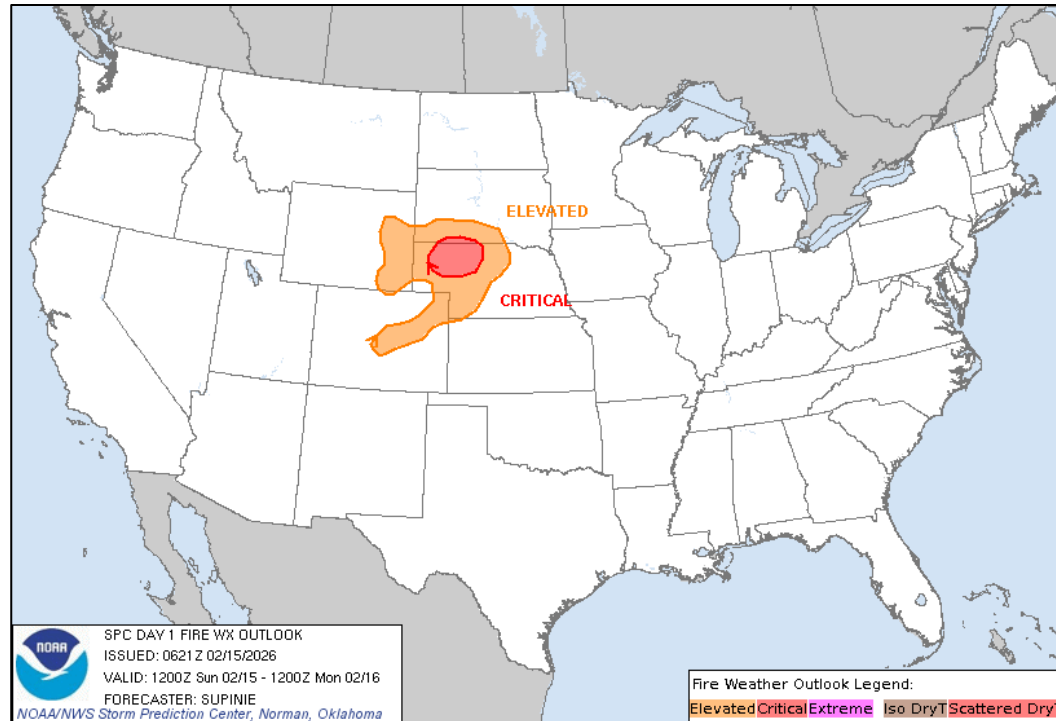
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



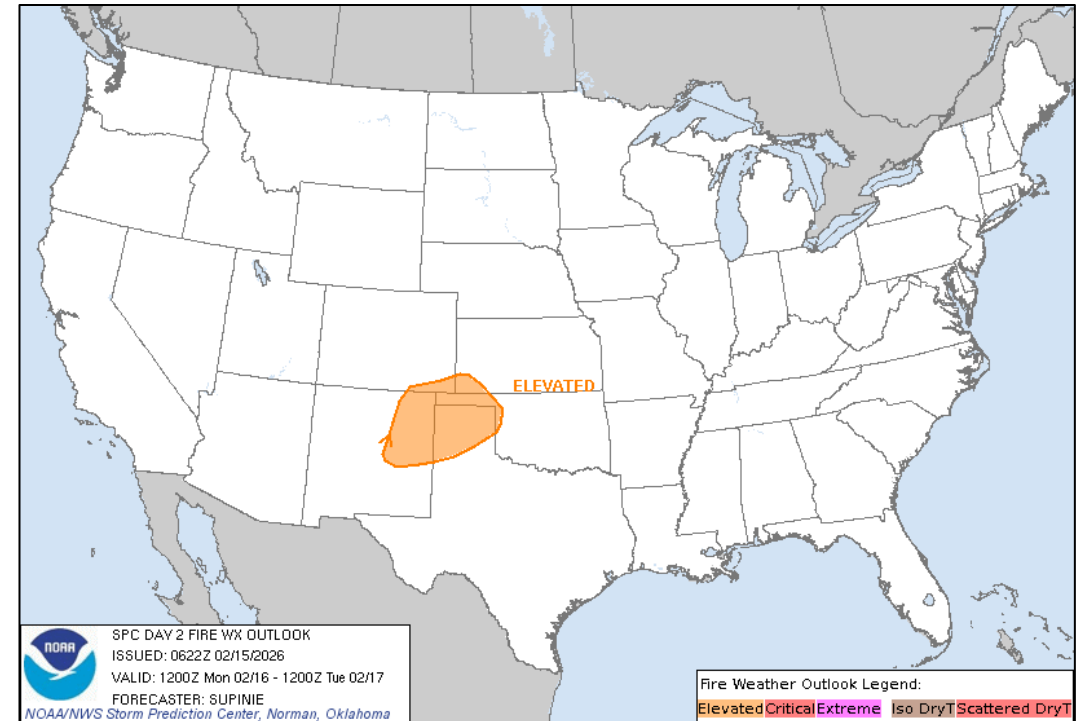

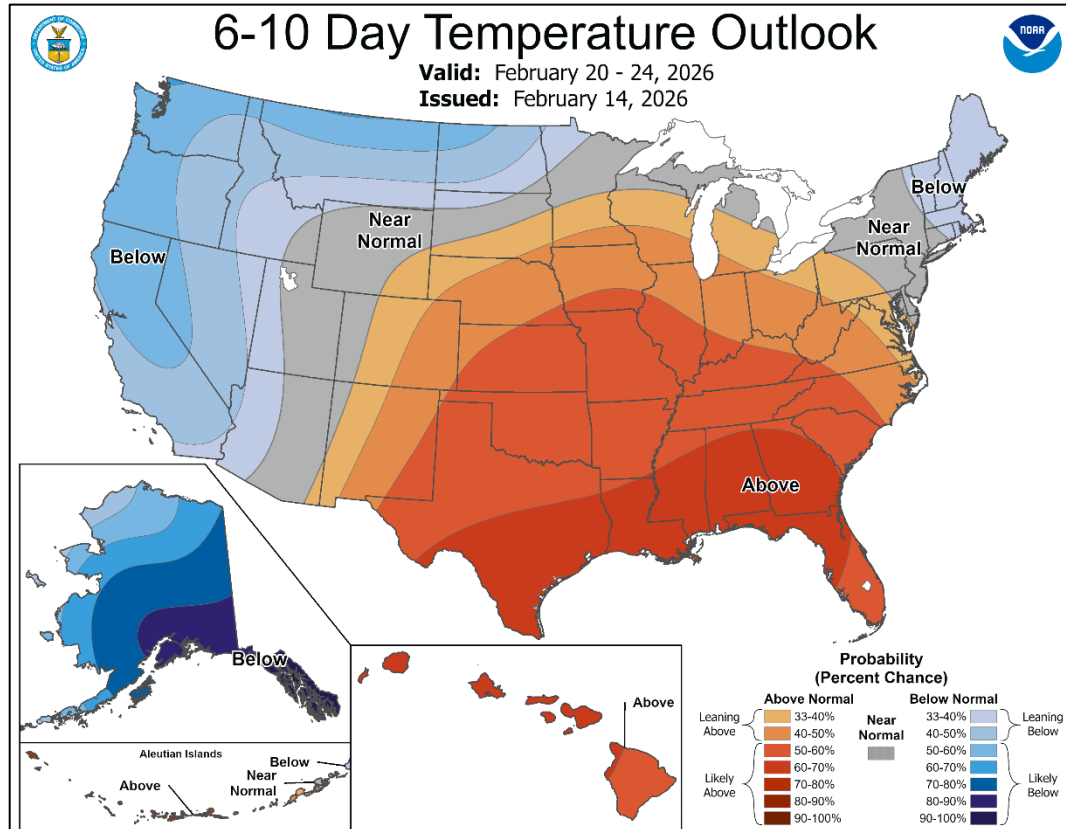

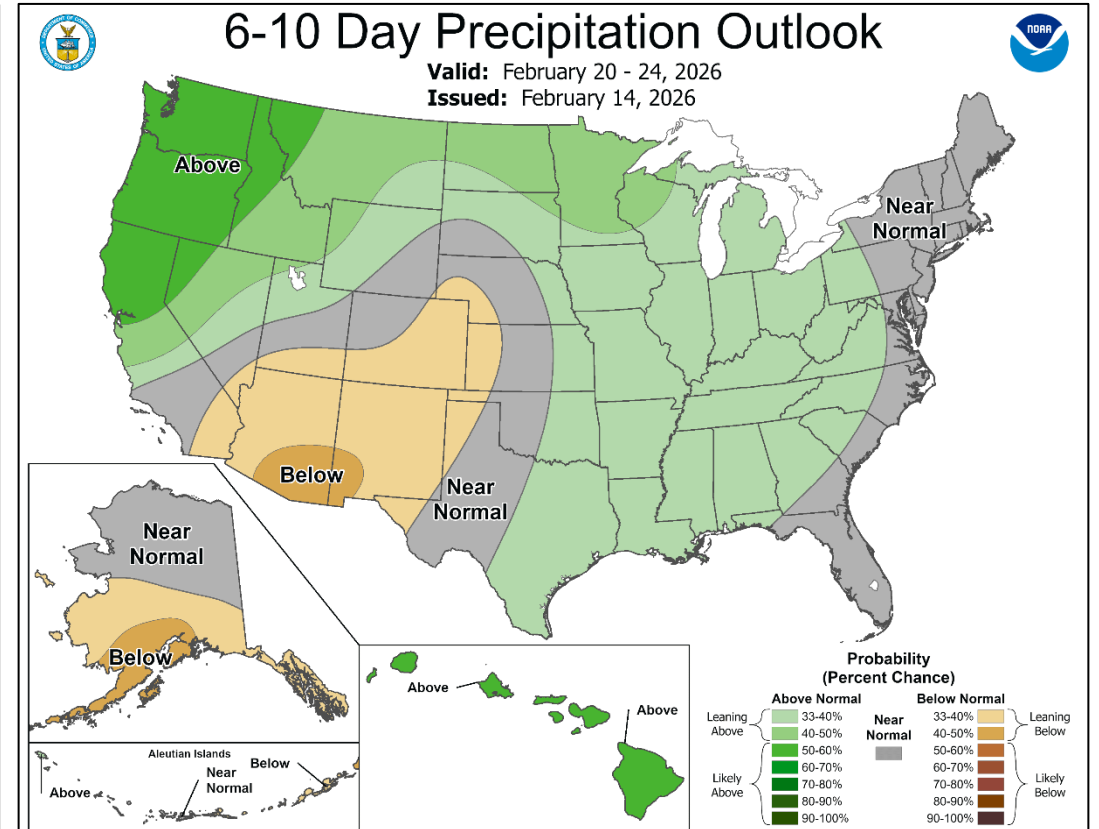
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Long Range Outlooks – Feb 20-24

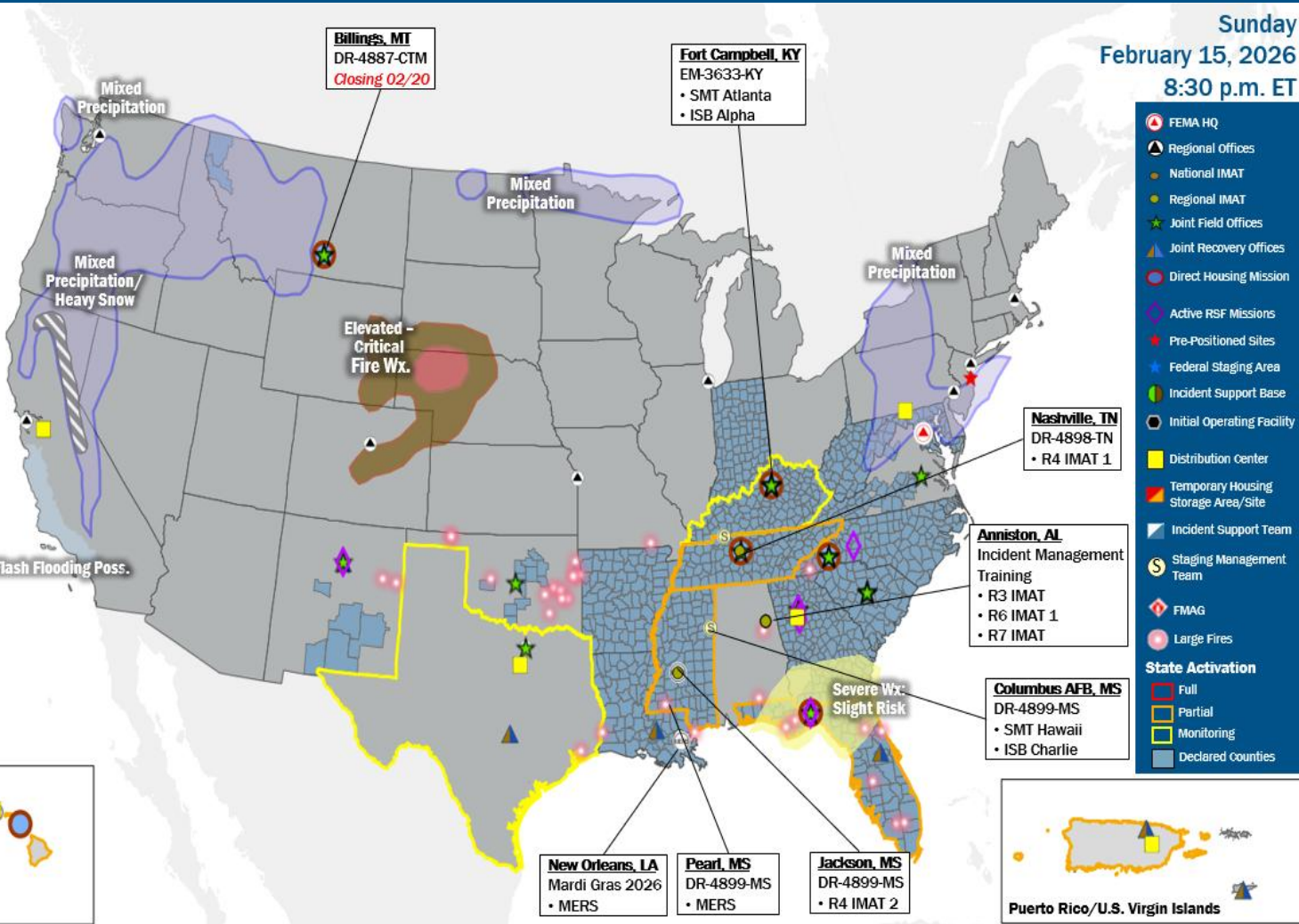
